- The work must be an original song. It cannot be an arrangement or adaptation of a traditional non-copyright work or another original work.
- Entry is open to all NZ residents and NZ citizens.
- Entries are limited to one song per entrant
- Unless specifically requested, the Ukulele Festival committee shall retain the copies of recordings submitted.
- The Ukulele Festival committee will have the right to print the name and likenesses of any entrant in publicity in respect of the competition and all matters incidental thereto.
- The entrant agrees to allow the Ukulele Festival committee to reproduce the details entered as required for the purposes of judging.
- The entrant agrees to be bound by entry procedures, and rules and regulations established in this entry form.
- The Ukulele Festival committee shall have the right to interpret the above conditions and to determine all issues arising out of this contest. Any such interpretations and determinations shall be final.
- All decisions in regards to the selection of the finalists and winners are binding. No correspondence will be entered into.
- The entrant is to ensure that all information given on the entry form is true and correct.
